

FOOD FOR PEOPLE DISTRIBUTION PANTRIES

The Eureka Choice Pantry allows folks to "shop" for items they need. Additional pantries receive distributions as listed below. Households may utilize the pantries once per month. **Currently, families with children under 18, and individuals over age 60 may receive 2 boxes per month.**

Below is a list of the maximum monthly income for each household size. If your household currently or unexpectedly has no income coming in, you qualify.
